## CALVARY CEMETERY

Calvary Cemetery is owned and operated by Mary of the Immaculate Conception Parish

### PRICES FOR THE PERMANENTLY LEASED LOTS

Parishioners	\$350.00 per lot
Non Parishioners	\$1,000.00 per lot

Persons having existing leases on lots not occupied can sell them in private for one half (1/2) of the present price but the cemetery personnel must be involved with the transfer of the lease so that it can be recorded.

### MONUMENTS AND MARKERS

All monuments and markers must be granite or bronze.

- A. The base of all monuments must have a pre-cast concrete or granite base with a minimum depth of 4 inches or a poured in place concrete base at least 8 inches in depth.
- B. All concrete bases must be at least 4 inches wider than the granite on all four sides.
- C. Grass markers must be at least 4 inches thick and have concrete around them on all four sides and at least 4 inches wider than the granite.
- D. Bronze government markers must be attached to a granite base that is at least 4 inches larger on all sides than the bronze or have concrete in which they are set that is at least 4 inches thick and 4 inches surrounding the bronze on all sides.
- E. Vaults are required for all burials, even cremation urns, unless they are granite or marble. All Catholic cemeteries in the diocese will require use of burial vault or grave liner (cremation remains included) to increase safety, efficiency and lower operating costs.
- F. Two cremation urns can be placed in one lot, but not on top of a burial vault. Lots are four foot six inches wide and the concrete or granite footing cannot exceed the four foot six inch width. The granite base cannot exceed three foot ten inches. The upright die can only be three foot two inches in length.
- G. No private mausoleums are permitted in the existing cemetery. Space for mausoleums may be provided in the future when new areas are developed.
- H. All graves must be dug by the Parish Authorized grave digger.
- I. No one can be buried without the authorization of the Parish.

## FLOWERS AND WREATHS

- A. Flowers may be on the graves from May 20 to June 15.
- B. Before May 20 and after June 15 all flowers must be attached to the monument above grade or be removed
- C. Single post flower stands are permitted at all times.
- D. Flowers that become detached from the grave site by wind and their original location cannot be determined will be discarded.

## VEHICLES IN THE CEMETERY

No vehicles may drive on graves. Only authorized installers may install monuments or sand blast dates on them. To do so they must plank for the vehicles tires to prevent sinkage and disturbing the sod.
